



Potty Training 101

Day 1-5

Take the puppy out every 2 hours.



Day 6-8

Take the puppy out every 2-4 hours.



Day 9-11

Take the puppy out every 3-4 hours.



Day 12 on

Take the puppy out every 4 hours.



Always take the puppy:

- First thing in the morning
- After meals
- After naps
- After playtime/excitement
- Before bedtime



TIPS & RULES:



- Puppies can typically hold their bladder for 1 hour per month of age (e.g., a 2-month-old puppy needs a break every 2 hours).
- Look out for sniffing, circling, whining, or sudden stops during play —these often indicate they need to go!
- If using peepads/pee tray, replace and wash it after they go 2-3 times max. —nobody likes a dirty toilet!
- Use the same cue word or phrase (e.g., "Go potty") while they're in the act, then praise & reward them WITHIN 2 SECS!
- NEVER scold or punish for accidents! This only creates fear for toileting in front of you! Use an enzymatic cleaner to remove odours.
- Limit water intake 1-2 hours before bedtime. Sips are ok.

With consistency, patience, and positive reinforcement, your puppy will quickly learn good toilet habits!
